

Magnify the LORD with me

Happy Wednesday!

“Magnify the LORD with me! Together let us lift his name up high!” Psalms 34:3

“Magnify the LORD, our God! Bow low at his footstool! He is holy!” Psalms 99:5

“Magnify the LORD our God! Bow low at his holy mountain because the LORD our God is holy!” Psalms 99:9

“I sought the LORD and he answered me. He delivered me from all my fears.” Psalms 34:4

“I raise my eyes toward the mountains. Where will my help come from? My help comes from the LORD, the maker of heaven and earth.” Psalms 121:1-2

What are you “magnifying”? Are you spending time thinking about how to solve life’s problems, or are you spending your time and energy praising God and blessing His Holy Name? What is stopping you from magnifying the Lord? It’ll save you from sleepless nights, anxiety, restore you, and give you a sound mind. What have you got to lose? After all, it’s easy to praise God when we have “everything.” Let US praise God even when we have nothing, like Job did. Praising God is not because of what tangible or circumstantial things we have received. It’s about praising Him because we have simply received Him.

Father, I praise You and thank you. Help me look to you, magnify you, and not be overwhelmed. You are my provider. You sustain me. You are my strength. You are my refuge and tower. You are timeless and unlimited. You are beyond comprehension and I praise you for that. You are my restoration. You are my redeemer. You are my perfect Father and faithful Friend.
